Olympus Products Update

OLYMPUS®

Olympus have announced the highly anticipated replacements to the highly popular DM-450 and DM-550.

The **DM-650** is the DM-450's replacement. Now with 4GB memory (expandable further through Micro-SD), there's space for over 1000 hours of recording, now able to record in PCM as well for high-quality audio.

With a new microphone system, using stereo directional condenser microphone and a centre Omni-directional, it allows for clearer recording and means that now there is practically no need for a Directional Microphone with it!

The **DM-670** is the DM-550's replacement. This comes with a fantastic 8GB of memory (again expandable through Micro-SD). It also features the same microphone as the DM-650, but has an added feature which will be well welcomed, as it has 99 Index Marks, instead of just 16.

Both of these new recorders will be available from the 10th October 2011, pricing to follow.



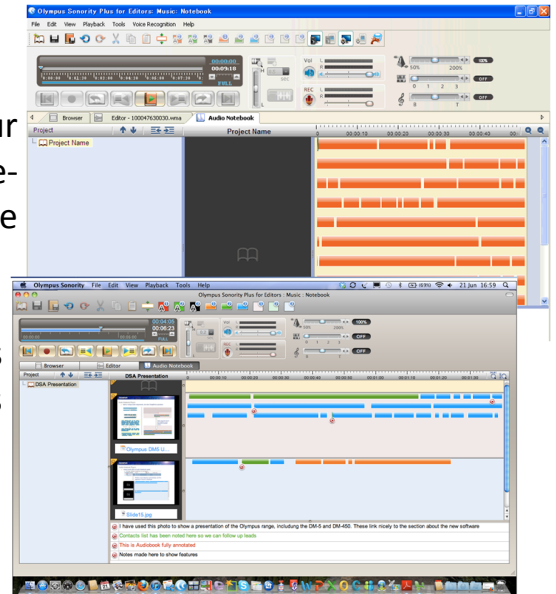

Nuance has released an update for Dragon Naturally Speaking 11. 11.5 reduces recognition errors even further, and introduces new voice commands, for posting to social networks and new text formatting, quotations and bracketing.

Another new feature is the ability to use an iPhone as a wireless microphone for Dragon through a free App. Allowing freedom of movement for students who don't like the restrictions of headsets.

All Dragon Version 11 owners will automatically upgrade to Version 11.5.
