Due to the nature of Rentals, Software becomes difficult to rent out due to the licensing, especially if the Student decides to purchase the equipment at the end of the Rental. As a result from now on Wyvern will only rent Hard Ware items out, and then all software or items not listed in the Rental section will need to be purchased as normal, and those items will be theirs to keep at the end. Our Rental packages can be 3 Months until 12 Months, anything longer will have to be a Purchase. A New Member to the WBS Team

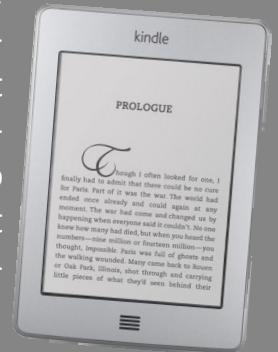

Changes to the Kindle Range



On the 28th September, Amazon held a press conference to announce a new range of products that they are going to release. The existing Kindle is now renamed the Kindle Keyboard. The reason for this is that they have released a couple of new models. The new entry level Kindle has lost its keyboard for a few simple buttons, in exchange for a significant price cut. While there is a new top end model called the Kindle Touch, which has an Infra-Red Touchscreen technology to allow swiping and scrolling to navigate through the books. At the moment however, only the new cheaper model is available for pre-ordering.



They have also released a Kindle Fire, a 7" Tablet powered by the Android Operating System, which is very similar in design and specification to the Blackberry Playbook. However there is no word of when this will be released in the UK.

New Wacom Tablets

Wacom have released a few new Bamboo Tablets, the Capture and the Create. There is also a larger Capture model, which is twice the size. The main features of these new models is the ability to go wireless via a RF Dongle (Purchased Separately). Whether these will have a UK release or not is unknown at this time, but it is highly likely that they will arrive here soon.
